CCIP GRANT ACTIVITIES

- Improvement Efforts
 - WICWA Continuous Quality Improvement Reviews
 - Several counties based on minimum number of WICWA cases
 - TPR Timeliness Project
 - Surveying counties with fastest and slowest TPR timeframes
 - Judicial Engagement Team (JET) Initiative
 - 3-county pilot began in 2014, now total of 9 counties
 - Tailored Dispositional Orders Project
 - Piloting in 3 counties next year, then expanding statewide
- Committees
 - Wisconsin Judicial Committee on Child Welfare
 - Wisconsin Commission on Children, Families and the Courts
 - Subcommittees as needed
 - Juvenile Clerks Workgroup
